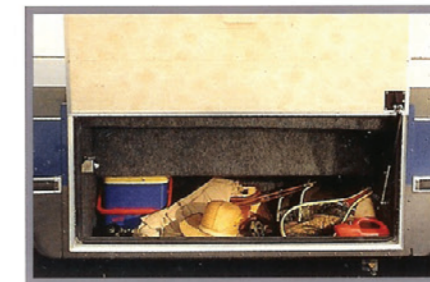

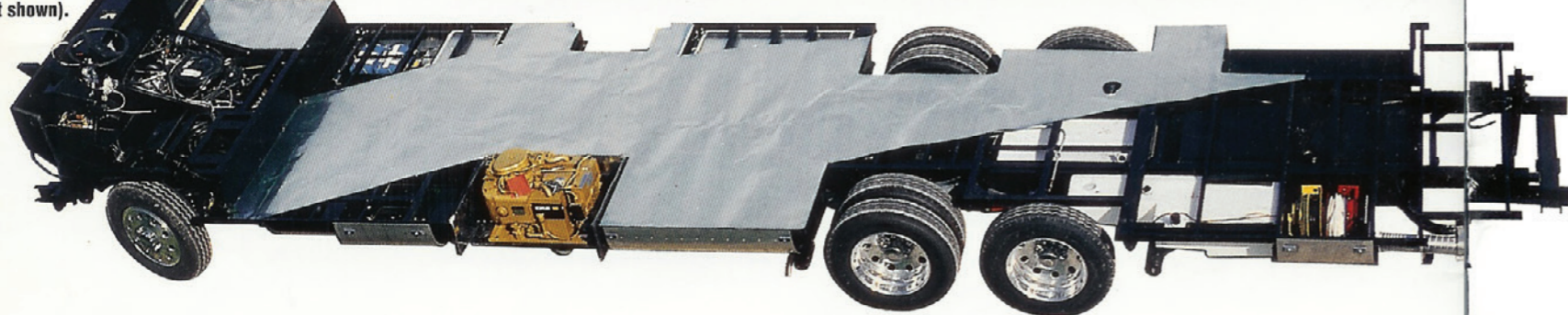

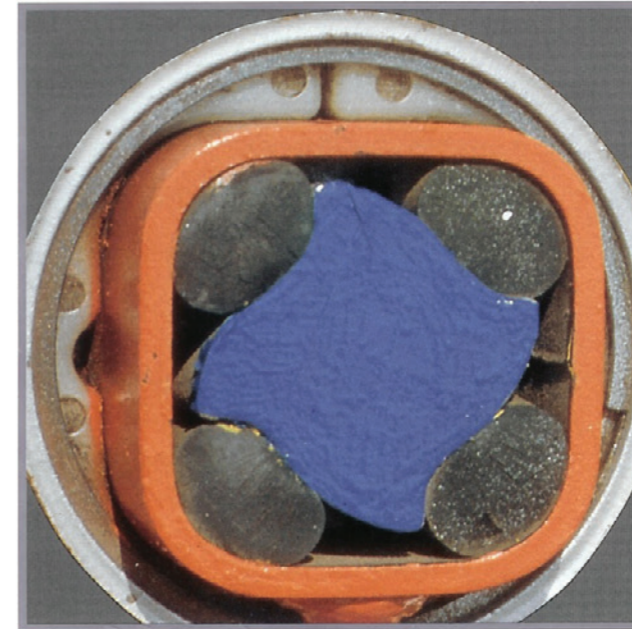

The Airstream fuselage is a remarkable example of strength with an inner and outer skin of light weight aluminum.



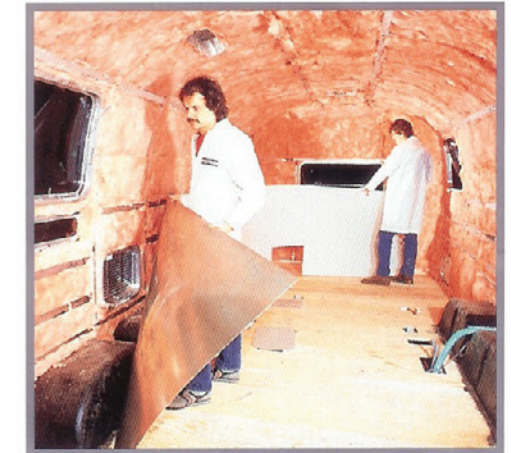

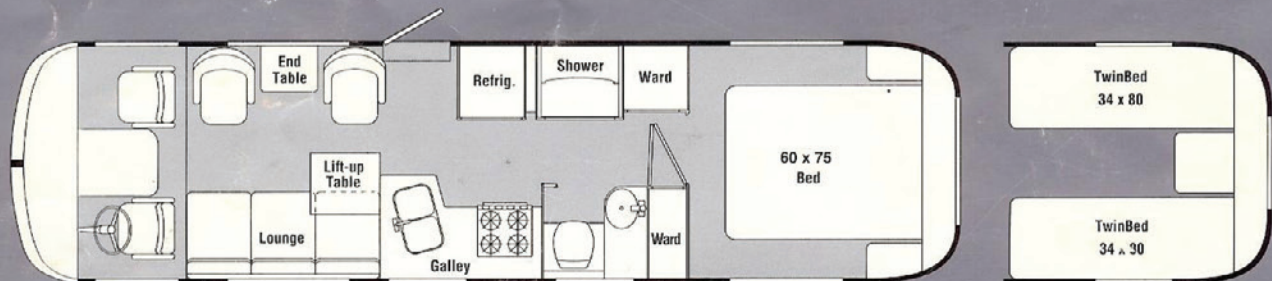
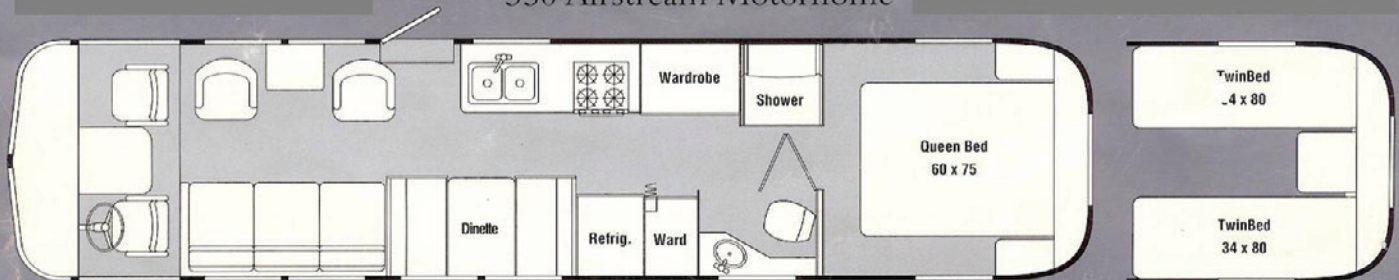
